- 1. Exhibitors in the SDJRA Futurity Show must be current SDJRA members. Dues are \$10 annually.
2. All animals must be purchased from one of the following sales. Holiday Sale, Sioux Empire Farm Show, Black Hills Stock Show or Watertown Winter Farm Show. The consignor must be a member of the SDRAA.
3. Animals entered in the SDJRA Futurity Show must be registered in the name of the junior exhibitor, his/her family's ranch, and must be in their ownership status (reflected on registration certificate).
4. Junior members may show an animal that is owned jointly with other owners but the junior member's name or family must be on the registration certificate
5. Grand Champion Female and Grand Champion Steer will receive \$250 cash. Reserve Champion Steers and Females will receive \$150 cash.
6. The breeder of the Grand Champion female and steer will receive \$250. The breeder of the Reserve Champion female and steer will receive \$150.
7. One junior exhibitor in the futurity will have their name drawn out of a hat to receive entry fee paid in full to the Red Angus Round-Up the following year.
8. One junior exhibitor in the futurity will have their name drawn out of a hat to receive \$300 credit at one of the futurity-qualifying sales the following year.
